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PROGRAMS:

Early Childhood & Pre-K / K Program

The Early Childhood & Pre-K / K Dance Program begins as early as 9 months with our Mommy & Me classes. We then offer Creative movement for ages 2yrs-4yrs, and our Combo classes are for students ages 3-6. These classes introduce the child to the foundations needed to carry into our Recreational and/or Competitive and Pre Professional programs. We focus on building the self-confidence, coordination skills, control, and muscle memory needed to bring into the more advanced levels of dance. All classes are taught within a fun and uplifting atmosphere. We want our students to develop their passion for the arts right from the start!

Recreational Program

Our recreational program has been created for students who prefer to just take classes once or twice a week without the demands of extra performances and rehearsals. Our rec. program is also designed to provide each student with top-notch training to better advance them if they plan to join our competition or pre professional teams in the future. The Future of Talent company allows their recreational students to improve their skills in a fun, upbeat atmosphere where their self-confidence is flourished. All recreational classes will be required to purchase a costume and will perform in at least 1-show at the end of the year recital.

RECREATIONAL DANCE CLASSES

All students are placed into classes based upon age and ability. It is mandated that all Future of Talent students take a minimum of 1/2 hour of ballet per week when enrolling in jazz and/or lyrical/contemporary classes.

Recreational Dance Classes include: BALLET JAZZ TAP LYRICAL ACROBATICS HIP-HOP MUSICAL THEA.

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Competition Team & Pre-Professional Program

The competition team and Pre-Professional Programs at The Future of Talent Co. have been created for the student who desires to pursue dance either as a career or at the collegiate level. Our educational curriculum is founded by the most classical ballet classes, mixed with our conditioning classes which flourish strength, power, and flexibility. We at the FOT focus on improving each performers' abilities along with their self-confidence and individuality which is carried throughout each genre we offer. To ensure the best quality of education, all students are placed into classes based upon both ability and age. Our program accepts students ages 4-7 for our Broadway bound level, and ages 6-18 for levels I, I and, III. We will hold annual open auditions for these programs. (Current audition information is listed below) Level placement will be determined by the program Director and/or guest instructors at the Pre-Professional Dance Auditions. We fully prepare all of our students with the education, skills, and motivation needed to achieve their dreams.

Our competition/ pre-pro dancers will have the opportunity to be seen annually by top talent management companies and talent agencies. Dancers in these programs will be offered special performance opportunities each year such as performing on National Television, at Walt Disney world, on stage with a Radio City Rockette and Broadway stars, as well as traveling to local dance competitions and to NYC for special workshop events.

PRE-PROFESSIONAL CLASSES

All students must attend the placement class audition before enrolling into classes. To ensure quality education all levels are final, unless otherwise directed by the studio director and/or instructors. *See requirements below
